dog (s) on any premises. Not only is it a rule, it can also be a major health issue to the neighborhood. It also costs Summerlakes money to pay our maintenance staff to take the time to pick up your pet's waste on the common grounds when shoveling or mowing. Trash cans are located at all of the park areas for proper disposal. Please - Be responsible for your pets' cleanup.
