> All fireworks EXCEPT these Class C are illegal

Per City Code, Class C fireworks are:

- Snakes or glowworm pellets
- smoke devices
- trick noisemakers (party poppers, booby traps, snappers, trick matches, cigarette loads, auto burglar alarms)
- Sparklers
- toy pistols (cap guns)
- toy canes
- toy guns, or other devices in which paper or plastic caps containing 5 one-hundredths (0.25) grain or less of explosive compound are used.

City Code will be enforced.

Possession or use of illegal fireworks carries a minimum \$250 fine.

ATTENTION, LOCAL RESIDENTS

I am a Warrenville resident who visits family in Edgebrook regularly. My family and I have had a number of incidents at the pedestrian bridge that crosses the creek between the Edgebrook neighborhood and Meadow and in the Kiwanis Park at Meadow and Home avenues. We have reported these to the police, but we also thought it wise to report our experiences to your HOA so that you can inform your residents.

A small group of men, mostly younger and one older with greying hair, have done the following on different occasions - use foul language towards us for no reason, asked a 15 year old for his phone, and physically threatened one of us while walking towards us (again unprovoked). The Warrenville police report that they have had multiple complaints about similar behaviors.

If you experience any situation that makes you feel uncomfortable or unsafe or see people loitering in the park after dark or a group of men loitering on or near the bridge, the Warrenville police department should be called and a report should be made. Call 91 1 immediately and report your situation to the police.

PET WASTE

PLEASE: When walking your dog (s) around the neighborhood, carry a plastic bag with you and please be courteous and pick up after your pet. City Ordinance states that residents must clean up immediately after their dog (s) on any premises. Not only is it a rule, it can also be a major health issue to the neighborhood. It also costs Summerlakes money to pay our maintenance staff to take the time to pick up your pet's waste on the common grounds when shoveling or mowing. Trash cans are located at all of the park areas for proper disposal. Please - Be responsible for your pets' cleanup.



ATTENTION RESIDENTS!

Shaw Drive, along with any other street or common area in Summerlakes is not a designated trash drop off! There is always a lot of debris left along Shaw Drive; televisions, toys, car seats, not to mention the usual trash such as cans, bottles, food bags, etc. Littering is a crime! Please take pride in your community and dispose of your trash in the appropriate fashion-don't leave it on the streets!

Trash cans are located at various parks and common areas for neighborhood walk by pick-up; however they are NOT to be used for your personal garbage disposal.

Televisions, furniture, appliances, etc. are not to be left out on the curside. Pick-up for these items must be arranged through Waste Management.

Also, please remember that there is no brush pick-up during the months of July and August. Tree trimmings, brush, etc. should not be left out on the curbside. This could result in fines.


COMMUNITY BULLETIN BOARD


You will not be able to close on your home without it. Giving less than the required two weeks notice may result in additional processing fees. Call the Clubhouse for the proper forms.


ANNUAL FAMILY PICNIC/PIG ROAST


