Please be respectful and clean up after your messes in the patio area and locker rooms. Regulation swimwear must be worn to swim. Basketball shorts, t-shirts and street clothes will not be allowed. Anyone not complying with these guidelines will be asked to leave. With everyone's cooperation we can all look forward to a fun and safe pool season!

All residents are required to have their Summerlakes ID. Guest must also have some form of ID before entering the Clubhouse and/or Pool. Homeowners must also be current with the monthly assessments to use the Clubhouse and/or Pool.

Ready to kick off an unforgettable season? Sign up today and be part of Spring Soccer! Sign up now for fall soccer action! Players are assigned to teams based on their grade entering the 2025/2026 school year. This volunteer-coached program introduces the fundamentals of playing soccer through weekly practices and a eight game schedule emphasizing proper technique, knowledge of rules, participation, sportsmanship, and fun. Players will be contacted by their coach after they have been assigned to a team. Teams can begin practicing the week of August 18th. Each player will be required to provide his/her own shin guards for practices and games. All volunteer coaches and assistant coaches must attend a mandatory coaches meeting at the Recreation Center on August 13th at 5:45P.

There will be an optional coach's clinic following the meeting at 6:45P.

### ILLINOIS LAW FOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLES

"It is unlawful for any person to drive or operate a non-highway vehicle upon any street, highway, or roadway in this State" - 625 ILC 5/11-1426.1

With summer here, more residents and visitors are out enjoying the fresh air - often on golf carts, motorized bikes, or similar vehicles. The Warrenville Police Department reminds everyone that many of these are classified as :Non-Highway Vehicles" under Illinois law and are not



legal on public roads. Please help keep our community safe by following the rules. Please check with the City of Warrenville Bicyclist & Pedestrian Advisory Commission for further rules and regulations.



#### ARCHITECTURAL REQUEST FORM

The first step of any construction, replacement or alteration on your property that is visible from the outside is to fill out an architectural request form. This includes fences, sidewalks, driveways, siding, roofs, gutters, doors, windows, and definitely additions of any sort. If you need a permit from the City, you will need approval from the SHA first.

Despite any horror stories that you may have heard or read about difficult HOA's that have unreasonable restrictions, SHA's requirements are very simple and concerned with maintain properties in the prevailing community standards. These are all listed online and in the materials everyone was given and agreed to when you purchased the property. They are all also consistent with City requirements.

This may seem like an annoying additional step but it can actually save you time and money. There is no charge for this service and the form can be reviewed quickly. We see many of the requests and can often spot items that we know the City will not approve, and give you advice on making your project compliant. We also might be aware of issues other homeowners have had with similar projects.

The biggest benefit to getting this form filled out and approved is that the work will be documented and stored at the Clubhouse in your property's file. When you want to sell, re-finance, update insurance, etc. all of this information, including the date, description, costs, contractor, etc. is all there in one place waiting for you. That this information is safely stored off site would be particularly helpful for filing an insurance claim in the event of fire or other disaster damaged records at your home.

#### **PET WASTE**

**PLEASE:** When walking your dog (s) around the neighborhood, carry a plastic bag with you and please be courteous and pick up after your pet. City Ordinance states that residents must clean up immediately after their dog (s) on any premises. Not only is it a rule, it can also be a major health issue to the neighborhood. It also costs Summerlakes money to pay our maintenance staff to take the time to pick up your pet's waste on the common grounds when shoveling or mowing. And neighbors who don't even have pets are finding waste in their yard. Dog waste receptacles are located at all of the park areas for proper disposal.

Please - Be courteous and responsible for your pets' cleanup.

# **Keep Dogs Leashed in Public**

In Warrenville, **dogs must be on a leash** when in public places. This City ordinance helps protect everyone - humans and pets alike.




