The Quest After-School Program for Warrenville Middle Schoolers



Quest is an after school and summer youth development program that offers Warrenville students in 6th to 8th grade an exciting combination of recreation, academic support, life skills training, service-learning opportunities and fun field trips. Our mission is to help young people reach their fullest potential by increasing academic success and aiding in the development of positive character and increased self-esteem.

Quest runs Monday through Friday from 3pm-6pm during the school year at Grace Church of DuPage located at 27w344 Galusha Avenue in Warrenville (near Hubble Middle School).

Daily Schedule (on days school is in session):

- 3pm-4pm: Elective/Sports/Snack
- 4pm-5pm: Academic Support/Homework completion
- 5pm-6pm: Varies each day but could include: Life skills, STEM, Teambuilding or Service Projects and optional Christian Education
- Friday "fun" days vary week to week and may include local field trips.
- Daily Schedule for non-school days: 10am to 4pm
- Academic tutoring is available
- Regular attendance is required – this is not a drop-in program.
- Tuition is \$25 per month per child and \$12.50 per month for each additional child in the household. (Some field trips and activities may have additional costs.) Scholarships are available.

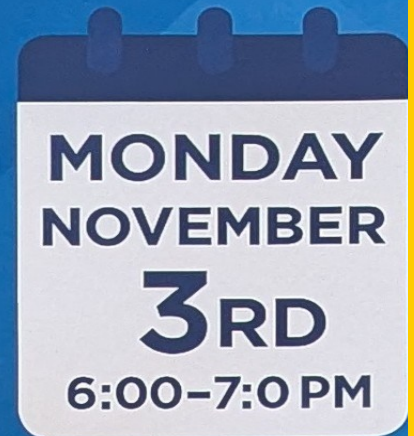

Outreach Warrenville is a Community Center serving low-income families in the Warrenville Community. We are inviting you to support our first annual Outreach Warrenville Community Christmas Store on Saturday, December 6, 2025.

The Christmas Store is an initiative, different from many other holiday season generosity models, that allows families served by Outreach Warrenville to purchase new, donated gifts at 75-80% off retail value, ensuring they can provide an affordable and dignified Christmas celebration for their children. This model empowers parents by allowing them to select and buy gifts at significantly reduced prices they can afford. The proceeds will go towards a Case Management client fund and programming at Outreach Warrenville throughout the year.

Some of our key services include:

- ◆ *Daily Afterschool Programs for 65 academically at risk youth throughout the year (Grades 2-12)*
- ◆ *Summer Programming - providing full-day enrichment for students from grades 2-8, and college and career exploration for high school students*
- ◆ *Family Stabilization Services, which offer crisis resources and connections to families in our community*
- ◆ *Mental Health Services through our Counseling Center, accessible to all families*


