#### FINAL BRUSH PICK-UP

The last brush pick-up for this year will be in October. Summerlakes falls within Zones 1 & 2.

Zone 1 (north of Batavia Road) - first Monday of October

Zone 2 (south of Batavia Road) - second Monday of October

Please keep in mind that brush is required to be out by 7:00 a.m. on the designated Monday, but pick-up may occur on a day later in that week.


Brush piles must comply with the following guidelines:

- One pile per address
- Pile cannot be greater than 3 feet in height, 8 feet in depth, and 15 feet in length
- Branches cannot be longer that 8 feet in length and no more than 8 inches in diameter
- Branches must be placed with the larger cut end toward the street

Brush pick-up is limited to trimmings (not tree removal) from bushes or shrubs, and branches from trimming and/or pruning trees. Other items such as logs, root balls, stumps, lumber, etc. will NOT be picked up. Brush piles that do not conform to these standards will NOT be picked up and a notice will be left on the front door. OUTDOOR BURNING REGULATIONS: With cooler weather arriving, please keep in mind the following permitted open burning regulations: Branches and twigs may be burned as long as they are dry and do not cause a large amount of smoke. Rec2reational fires and small landscape waste fires are permitted up to 2 feet by 2 feet by 2 feet in an approved container with a spark arrestor as long as it is no closer than 15 feet to any temporary or permanent struc ture (including fences, garages, houses, patios, etc.). Open burning in a container that is not approved and no larger than 2' by 2' by 2' in size, must be located 50 feet from any temporrary or permanent structure and must be covered with a spark arrestor. Open burning greater in size than 2' by 2' by 2' requires an open burning permit, which may be obtained at City Hall. Open burning greater than 5' by 5' by 5' is not permitted except for ecological manage-

ment, and requires an IEPA burning permit. Violations of the open burning ordinance may result in a \$75 fine. Please call the Community Development Department at (630) 393-9050 for more information.
