**POOL** - We are putting the last touches on the pool project. The front access walkway has been completed. This will allow easier and quicker entry for both emergency personnel and those with limited mobility. The final bills are coming in and this project will be at or slightly under what we had estimated. For a

project this big and complex this is amazing.

<u>PONDS</u> - We are aware that the ponds, particularly those on the north side of Summerlakes have had issues this year. This has been discussed with our current pond maintenance contractor and other companies. Corrective measures have already been taken to address the algae bloom on these ponds which has been more successful on the western pond. We have also been advised that much of the vegetation on and around these are non-native, invasive plants which need to be removed. All plant removal will be on SHA property only, not on private property. Weather and staff permitting, this problem will begin to be addressed this fall with a current plan to continue in the spring.



#### **BRUSH PICK-UP RESUMES IN SEPTEMBER**

Free brush pick-up will begin September 3rd! Summerlakes falls within Zones 1\* & 2\*.

Zone 1 - Tuesday, September 3rd \*(North of Batavia Road)

Zone 2 - Monday, September 9th \*(South of Batavia Road)

Please keep in mind that although brush is required to be set out by 7:00 a.m. on the designated Monday, pickup may occur on a day later in that week.

Brush piles must comply with the following guidelines:

- Limit is one pile per address.
- Put out piles prior to 7:00 a.m. on the day of the pickup.
- Pile cannot be greater than 3 feet in height, 8 inches in diameter, 8 feet wide and 15 feet in length
- Branches cannot exceed 8 feet in length and no more than 8 inches in diameter
- Branches must be placed with the larger cut ends toward the street; if not the pile will not be picked up.
- All brush must be bundled securely with twine, no wire.
- Bundles must not exceed 50 pounds.
- No logs, lumber, yard waste, thorns or root-balls.
- All brush under 2 feet long is considered yard waste and should be placed in yard waste bags with a
  yard waste sticker, to be picked up on your designated garbage day.
- Brush placed in plastic bags or other containers will not be picked up by the City.

Brush piles that do not conform to these standards will not be picked up and a notice will be left on the front door. Call the City Public Works Department at 630.393.9050 for more information.

further notice.


The **pool will remain open** for a while longer as long as we have cooperating weather, to be determined on a weekly basis as September progresses.

#### **FYI**

The City of Warrenville is in the process of applying for an ITEP (Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program) grant that will help to fund a project that will greatly benefit the residents of the community. The project consists of a 10-foot wide asphalt multiuse path, accessible to pedestrians and bicyclists, that will run along the west side of Route 59 between Continental Drive/Meadow Avenue and Batavia Road. Along the same stretch of Route 59, on the east side of the road, a 5-foot wide sidewalk is proposed. These paths will provide an ADA compliant route for residents to safely and easily access local parks, public transportation, and businesses.

The proposed improvements provide an alternative for non-motorized travel in order to access the nearby commercial, residential, educational, and recreational areas. These improvements will also enhance the aesthetics of this important corridor within the City..


